MARINE FORECAST (FISHING)

DATE: TUESDAY 21ST JANUARY, 2025.

VALIDITY: FOR 24 HOURS FROM 1800UTC, TUESDAY 21ST TO WEDNESDAY 22ND JANUARY 2025.

INSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2: *Up to 20 Nautical miles (37km) inside the Sea*

SEA SAFETY ADVISORY ALERT: The sea is expected to be rough with significant wave height and strong winds especially over the offshore areas.

Fishermen and other users of the sea are advised to use maximum sea safety advisory regulations in all fishing landing sites across the country. This condition is expected to commence Wednesday on the 22nd January 2025 at 1200z through on the early hours of Saturday 25th January 2025 at 0000z.

Winds: Will vary between North and Northwesterly flow with a speed ranging from 08–21km/h.

Wave Height: will be 0.4 – 1.1 meters high.

Sea State: Slight

Weather: Fair

Visibility: Good

OFFSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2: *From 20 up to 200 Nautical Miles (37km - 370km) into the high Sea*

Winds: Will vary between North and Northwesterly flow with a speed ranging from 13–26km/h.

Wave Height: Will be 1.2 – 2.5 meters high.

Sea State: Slight to Rough

Weather: Fair

Visibility: Good

HIGH TIDE:

COASTAL AREAS UP TO 10 NAUTICAL MILE (NM) ONSHORE:

Winds: Will be varying between northwesterly and Northerly flow with a speed ranging from 05-14km/h.
