WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: SUNDAY 16th FEBRUARY, 2025

TONIGHT: Cool and dry weather with hazy conditions of varying intensity will prevail over the country.

TOMORROW: Cool, dry and hazy conditions will persist in the morning, becoming mostly sunny afterwards.

WINDS: Will vary mainly between northwesterly and northerly flow across the country with speed ranging from 06 – 23 km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 17°C over the North Bank Region, whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 39°C over the Upper River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over the Upper River Region at 07:18 AM and the Greater Banjul area at 07: 28 AM, and will set at 07:02 PM and 07:12 PM over the Upper River Region and the Greater Banjul area

respectively.
