DATE: SATURDAY 22ND FEBRUARY, 2025.

VALIDITY: FOR 24 HOURS FROM 1800UTC, SATURDAY 22ND TO SUNDAY 23RD

FEBRUARY, 2025.

<u>SEA SAFETY ADVISORY ALERT</u>: Rough sea with significant wave heights of (3.1m) and strong winds of (34km/h) will persist over The Gambia territorial waters.

The wind force and wave heights will continue to be rough especially over the offshore areas. These conditions will continue until tomorrow midday, $23^{\rm rd}$ February, 2025.

The fishermen and other users at the sea are advice to observe maximum sea safety regulations at all fishing landing sites during the period.

INSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2: Up to 20 Nautical miles (37km) inside the Sea

Winds: Will vary between northerly and northeasterly flow with speed ranging from 10 - 32 km/h.

Wave Height: will be 1.4–3.0 meters high.

Sea State: Slight to Rough

Weather: Slight haze

Visibility: Moderate

<u>OFFSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2:</u> <u>From 20 up to 200 Nautical Miles (37km - 370km)</u> <u>into the high Sea</u>

Winds: Will be mainly northerly flow with speed ranging from 16 - 34

km/h.

Wave Height: Will be 2.4 – 3.1 meters high.

Sea State: Moderate to Rough

Weather: Slight haze

Visibility: Moderate
