WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: MONDAY 17TH MARCH, 2025

TONIGHT: Light to moderate winds with slight haze condition will prevail over the western sector.

TOMORROW: Slight winds with hazy condition expected to persist in the morning, becoming hot and sunny during the afternoon.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow across the country with speed ranging from 06 – 22km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 20°C over the North Bank Region, whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 42°C over the Lower River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 07:01 AM and over Greater Banjul area at 07: 11 AM, and will set at 07:06 PM and 07:16 PM over Upper River Region.
