WEATHER FORECAST DATE: SUNDAY 16TH MARCH, 2025

TONIGHT: Occasionally breezy and cool condition will prevail over most part of the country.

TOMORROW: Cool and Occasionally breezy atmosphere is expected to persist in the morning, becoming hot and sunny during the afternoon.

WINDS: Will vary between northwesterly and northerly flow across the country with speed ranging from 06 - 25 km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 20°C over the North Bank and Greater Banjul Regions, whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 41°C over the Lower River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 07:07 AM and over Greater Banjul area at 07: 17 AM, and will set at 07:06 PM and 07:16 PM over Upper River Region.
