MARINE FORECAST (FISHING)

DATE: SUNDAY 09TH MARCH, 2025.

VALIDITY: FOR 24 HOURS FROM 1800UTC, SUNDAY 09TH TO MONDAY 10TH MARCH 2025.

SEA SAFETY ADVISORY ALERT: Rough sea with significant wave heights of (2.8m) and strong winds of (34km/h) will prevail over The Gambia territorial waters from Tomorrow 9:00am the 10th March 2025.

The wind force and wave heights will continue to be rough especially over the offshore areas. These conditions will continue until 2:00 pm Friday 14th March, 2025.

Fishermen and other users at the sea are advice to use maximum sea safety regulations at all fishing landing sites during the period.

INSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2: Up to 20 Nautical miles (37km) inside the Sea

Winds: Will be mainly northerly flow with speed ranging from 14 - 34 km/h.

Wave Height: will be 0.5 – 1.1 meters high.

Sea State: Slight

Weather: Fair V**isibility**: Good

<u>OFFSHORE WATERS- 1 & 2: From 20 up to 200 Nautical Miles (37km - 370km)</u> into the high Sea

Winds: Will be northerly flow with speed ranging from 25 - 36 km/h.

Wave Height: Will be 1.2–2.5 meters high.

Sea State: Slight to Rough

Weather: Fair

Visibility: Good

HIGH TIDE:

Tonight: will be at 7:13 PM

Tomorrow: will be at 7:52 AM

LOW TIDE:

Tomorrow: will be at 1:23 AM

And also: will be at 1:24 PM

COASTAL AREAS UP TO 10 NAUTICAL MILE (NM) ONSHORE:

Winds: Will vary between northwesterly and northerly flow with a speed ranging from 08-24 km/h.

Temperatures: Min: 18°C and Max: 29°C =
