WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: MONDAY 28TH APRIL, 2025

TONIGHT: Fair weather with slightly hazy conditions will prevail over the country.

TOMORROW: Stable atmosphere and slightly hazy conditions are expected to persist over the country, thereafter becoming sunny and hot especially over the inland sector.

WINDS: Will vary mainly between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 06 – 24 km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 19°C over the North Bank Region, whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 39°C over the Upper River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:35 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:45, and will set at 07:11 PM and 07:21 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
