WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: FRIDAY 02ND MAY, 2025.

TONIGHT: Fairly cool with moderate breezy winds will prevail over the coastal region while inland expected to be fairly warm with slightly hazy conditions.

TOMORROW: Chances of slight rains are expected to prevail over the inland sector in the early hours of the morning, thereafter becoming sunny and hot with persisting slightly hazy conditions.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the western region, while over the inland southwesterly to easterly flow with speed ranging from 06 – 22 km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 20°C over the North Bank Region, whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 36°C over the Upper and Central River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:34 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:44, and will set at 07:12 PM and 07:22 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
