WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: TUESDAY 20TH MAY, 2025

TONIGHT: Stable atmosphere will prevail over the country during the period.

TOMORROW: Occasionally breezy winds with low chances of slight rain expected to prevail in the early morning hours over the inland, becoming sunny and hot during the afternoon.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow with speed ranging from 06-22km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 21°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 41°C over Upper River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:29AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:39AM, and will set at 07:17 PM and 07:27 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.

OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY 22ND MAY, 2025:

Slightly hazy and occasionally breezy conditions are expected to prevail becoming warm and sunny throughout the day.

Breezy winds with slight haze are expected to prevail over the eastern sector, thereafter becoming warm and sunny as the day progresses.
