#### WEATHER FORECAST

**DATE:** WEDNESDAY 28<sup>TH</sup> MAY, 2025

**TONIGHT**: Occasionally breezy with slightly hazy conditions will prevail over the country, particularly over the inland.

**TOMORROW**: Fairly cool in the morning, becoming generally warm during the afternoon, with persistent of slight haze through the day.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow across the country with speed ranging from 09-21km/h.

**TEMPERATURES:** The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 21°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 39°C over the Upper River Region.

**SUNRISE AND SUNSET:** The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:28 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:38, and will set at 07:19 PM and 07:29 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
