### WEATHER FORECAST

**DATE:** SATURDAY 31<sup>ST</sup> MAY, 2025

**TONIGHT:** Slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms will prevail over the country particularly over inland.

**TOMORROW:** Cloudy to partly cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning , becoming sunny and warm during the afternoon with chances of thunderstorms in the evening.

**WINDS:** Will be westerly flow over the Coast while Southwesterly over inland with speed ranging from 07-22km/h.

**TEMPERATURES:** The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 21°C over North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 36°C over Central and Upper River Regions respectively.

**SUNRISE AND SUNSET:** The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:29 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:39, and will set at 07:15 PM and 07:25 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
