WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: THURSDAY 12TH JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Humid and partly cloudy conditions will prevail over the western sector chances of thunderstorms and rain over the eastern sector late in the night.

TOMORROW: Cool and partly cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming sunny in the afternoon.

WINDS: Will vary mainly between westerly and southwesterly flow over the Country with speed ranging from 07-22km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 24°C over Banjul and North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 35°C over the Lower River Region, Central River Region, Upper River Region respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:28 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:38, and will set at 07:20 PM and 07:30 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
