WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: SUNDAY 15TH JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Variably cloudy conditions and occasionally breezy winds will prevail over the coastal region; while over inland will be humid with low chances of rains.

TOMORROW: Partly cloudy to variably cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, thereafter becoming warm and humid, with chances of thunderstorms and rains expected over the inland sector during late evening.

WINDS: Will vary mainly between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 12 - 22km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 36°C over the Central River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:29 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:39, and will set at 07:24 PM and 07:34 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
