WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: TUESDAY 17TH JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Stable atmosphere will prevail over the country during the period.

TOMORROW: Humid atmosphere is expected to prevail, with chances of slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms over places particularly the inland sector from early part of the night towards morning hours.

WINDS: Will vary mainly between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 07- 20km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 35°C over the West Coast Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:30 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:40, and will set at 07:25 PM and 07:35 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
