WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: WEDNESDAY 18TH JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Moderate breezy conditions will prevail over the country, particularly over the eastern sector.

TOMORROW: Cloudy condition are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming warm and sunny during the afternoon.

WINDS: Will vary mainly between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 04- 21km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 38°C over the Central River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:30 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:40, and will set at 07:25 PM and 07:35 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
