WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: THURSDAY 19TH JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Variably cloudy and occasionally breezy conditions will prevail over coastal region, while over inland chances of thunderstorms and rains expected from late parts of the night.

TOMORROW: Chances of thunderstorms and rains are expected to prevail over the inland sector from early parts of the morning, thereafter becoming warm and humid with sunny spells through the day.

WINDS: Will vary mainly between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 08 - 22km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 36°C over the Lower, Central, and Upper River Regions Respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:32 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:42, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
