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### WEATHER FORECAST

**DATE:** THURSDAY 19<sup>TH</sup> JUNE, 2025

**TONIGHT:** Variably cloudy and occasionally breezy conditions will prevail over coastal region, while over inland chances of thunderstorms and rains expected from late parts of the night.

**TOMORROW:** Chances of thunderstorms and rains are expected to prevail over the inland sector from early parts of the morning, thereafter becoming warm and humid with sunny spells through the day.

**WINDS:** Will vary mainly between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 08 - 22km/h.

**TEMPERATURES:** The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 36°C over the Lower, Central, and Upper River Regions Respectively.

**SUNRISE AND SUNSET:** The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:32 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:42, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
