WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: SATURDAY 21ST JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Stable atmosphere will prevail over the country during the night.

TOMORROW: Variably cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming hot and sunny with chances of slight rain and thunderstorms over places particularly the western sector during the evening.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 07-20km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 35°C over West Coast, North Bank Central River and Upper River Region respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:30 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:40, and will set at 07:25 PM and 07:35 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.

OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY 23RD JUNE, 2025
