#### WEATHER FORECAST

**DATE: SATURDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> JUNE, 2025** 

**TONIGHT**: Stable atmosphere will prevail over the country during the night.

**TOMORROW**: Variably cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming hot and sunny with chances of slight rain and thunderstorms over places particularly the western sector during the evening.

**WINDS:** Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 07-20km/h.

**TEMPERATURES:** The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 35°C over West Coast, North Bank Central River and Upper River Region respectively.

**SUNRISE AND SUNSET:** The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:30 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:40, and will set at 07:25 PM and 07:35 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
