WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: SUNDAY 22ND JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Gentle breeze with partly cloudy conditions will prevail over the country with low chances of thunderstorms and rain.

TOMORROW: Dry and sunny atmosphere are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming partly cloudy to cloudy as the day progresses.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and northwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 05-19km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 37°C over the Upper River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:31 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:41, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
