WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: MONDAY 23RD JUNE, 2025

TONIGHT: Humid atmosphere with slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms will prevail over places from evening hours onwards particularly over the central and inland sector during the period.

TOMORROW: Partly cloudy, sunny and warm in the afternoon. Thundry activities are expected to prevail over places in the evening hours particularly inland.

WINDS: Will be mainly westerly flow over the coast while southwesterly flow over the inland sector with speed ranging from 10-26km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 37°C over the inland sector.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:31 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:41, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Greater Banjul and Upper River Region.
