WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: THURSDAY 11TH JUNE, 2026

TONIGHT: Slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms are expected to prevail over the country, which may be accompanied by strong winds.

TOMORROW: Generally cloudy and breezy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming warm and humid during the day.

WINDS: Will be mainly southwesterly flow with speed ranging from 10–30km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 21°C over North Bank Regions whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 34°C over Lower and Central River Regions respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:29AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:39AM, and will set at 07:23 PM and 07:33 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
