WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: TUESDAY 16TH JUNE, 2026

TONIGHT: Low chances of slight rain and thunderstorm expected over eastern sector during late night.

TOMORROW: Low chances of rain expected over the coast in morning hours, becoming warm during the day.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 06–26km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 21°C over North Bank Region, whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 37°C over Lower River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:30AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:40AM, and will set at 07:25 PM and 07:35 PM over the Upper River and Greater Banjul respectively.
