WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: SUNDAY 21st JUNE, 2026

TONIGHT: Partly cloudy conditions with chances of slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms over the eastern sector during the period.

TOMORROW: It is expected to be warm and humid in the morning with chances of rain and thunderstorms over the country in the afternoon hours.

WINDS: Will be mainly southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 07–26km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over the North Bank Regions whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 35°C over Central River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:31AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:41AM, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
