WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: THURSDAY 25TH JUNE, 2026

TONIGHT: Variably cloudy conditions with chances of slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms expected to prevail over places particularly the inland sector.

TOMORROW: Low chances of rain are expected to affect some places in the morning, particularly the western parts of the country, becoming warm and humid with sunny spells through the rest of day.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southerly flow over the country with speed ranging from 08 – 28km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is 24°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is 36°C over the Lower River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:31AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:41AM, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
