WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: MONDAY 29TH JUNE, 2026

TONIGHT: Fair weather is expected to persist over the country during the period.

TOMORROW: Variable to cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming warm and humid with sunny spell during the day.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly to southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 07–28km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Regions whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 34°C over the West Coast, Lower River and Central River Region respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:31AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:41AM, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
