WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: WEDNESDAY 01ST JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Variably cloudy to cloudy conditions with chances of rain and thunderstorms over places, particularly the inland sector.

TOMORROW: Variably cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning with low chances of rains over some parts of the country, becoming warm and humid as the day progresses.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southerly flow over the country with speed ranging from 08 – 26km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over the North Bank Regions whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 34°C over the Upper River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:33AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:43AM, and will set at 07:27 PM and 07:37 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
