WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: SUNDAY 05TH JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Chances of slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms particularly over the Eastern sector around 0600z.

TOMORROW: Generally cloudiness is expected to prevail in the morning, becoming warm and during the afternoon.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 07–26km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Regions whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 34°C over West Coast, Lower River, and Central River Regions respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:31AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:41AM, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
