WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: TUESDAY 07TH JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms which may be associated with strong winds will prevail over the country particularly the inland sector from late night towards dawns.

TOMORROW: Variably cloudy conditions will prevail in the morning, becoming warm and humid with sunny spells through the day.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 08 – 30km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 20°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 35°C over the Lower and Upper River Regions respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:34AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:44AM, and will set at 07:27 PM and 07:37 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
