WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: WEDNESDAY 08TH JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Slight to Moderate rain and thunderstorms are expected to prevail over the inland sector, which may be accompanied with strong winds starting from 3:00am onwards.

TOMORROW: Variably to partly cloudy conditions will prevail in the morning, becoming warm and sunny through the day.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 08 – 30km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 34°C over the North Bank, Lower, Central and Upper River Regions respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:34AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:44AM, and will set at 07:27 PM and 07:37 PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
