WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: WEDNESDAY 22ND JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Strong winds with slight to moderate expected over the country during the night.

TOMORROW: Its expected to be generally cloudy in the morning, becoming warm during the afternoon.

WINDS: Will be mainly southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 10–28km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank and Central River Regions whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 33°C over Lower and Central River Regions respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:38AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:48AM, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
