WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: THURSDAY 23RD JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Chances of rain and thunderstorms are expected to prevail over places, particularly the western sector.

TOMORROW: Variable cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming warm with chances of rain and thunderstorms over places late in the afternoon, particularly over inland sectors.

WINDS: Will vary between southwesterly and westerly flow over the country with speed ranging from 10–25km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 23°C over the North Bank whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 34°C over Lower, Central and North Bank Region respectively.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:39 AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:49 AM, and will set at 07:26 PM and 07:36PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
