WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: SATURDAY 25TH JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Chances of slight to moderate rain and thunderstorms are expected to prevail over the Western sector around the early part of the forecast period.

TOMORROW: Variably cloudy conditions are expected to prevail in the morning, becoming warm and humid during the day.

WINDS: Will be southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 08 – 20km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 33°C over North Bank and Greater Banjul Areas.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:38AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:48AM, and will set at 07:27 PM and 07:37PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
