WEATHER FORECAST

DATE: MONDAY 27TH JULY, 2026

TONIGHT: Chances of Slight to moderate rain and thunderstorm over places particularly the western sector.

TOMORROW: It is expected to be warm and humid with chances of rain and thunderstorms over places in the evening hours.

WINDS: Will vary between westerly and southwesterly flow over the country with speed ranging from 10 – 25km/h.

TEMPERATURES: The lowest minimum value is expected to drop to 22°C over North Bank Region whereas; maximum value is expected to reach 34°C over Central River Region.

SUNRISE AND SUNSET: The sun is expected to rise over Upper River Region at 06:40AM and over Greater Banjul at 06:50AM, and will set at 07:25 PM and 07:35PM over Upper River Region and Greater Banjul respectively.
